There will be room for all returning vendors but sign up soon—we will make every effort not to have duplicating merchandise! (Save a copy of this sheet to refer to when setting up on December 9!)
- ~ All booths are "approximately 10 x 10 feet" available for \$85.00 or \$115.00 if electricity required—limited number of these. (All booths are outside—the Famous Cookie Walk is inside!) Check-in will begin at 7am.
- ~ Space outlines will be marked and will be available on a first come, first served, basis. We set up exact number of spaces as we have reservations for. A member of the Montgomery Historical Society will check you in—look for Bea at the Community Building. DO NOT set up prior to checking in unless you check with Bea if you have a truck or trailor and have made arrangements with her. Please, no garage sale or flea market items. For vendors paying for electricity, your space is assigned—we will have your name posted on your spot; vendors with 2 or more booths will also be marked.
- ~ Vendors will need to provide tables, chairs, tent, etc. and if electricity required, extension cords. We hope that you will join us in offering a total Christmas experience for families visiting Historic Montgomery.
