~ All booths are "approximately 10 x 10 feet" **available for \$85.00 or \$115.00 if electricity required—limited number of these.** (All booths are outside—the Famous Cookie Walk is inside!) **Check-in will begin at 7am.**

~ Space outlines will be marked and will be available on a first come, first served, basis. We set up exact number of spaces as we have reservations for. A member of the **Montgomery Historical Society** will check you in—look for Bea at the Community Building. **DO NOT set up prior to checking in unless you check with Bea if you have a truck or trailer and have made arrangements with her. Please, no garage sale or flea market items.** **For vendors paying for electricity, your space is assigned—we will have your name posted on your spot; vendors with 2 or more booths will also be marked.**

~ Vendors will need to provide tables, chairs, tent, etc. and if electricity required, extension cords. We hope that you will join us in offering a total Christmas experience for families visiting Historic Montgomery.
